Training for Sustainable Services

This research project, led by Brunel University London, includes 7 partners and 7 associate partners across 7 European countries.

We will review ‘**best practices**’ in each local context, and use this learning to **develop training programmes** appropriate to our cultural and institutional contexts.

Each partner university will **pilot a training model** with 80 of its own staff and conduct an independent evaluation of it.

The learning from these evaluations will be shared across the partnership, and the training models made **available free of charge**, via an **online portal**.

The aim of the USVreact project is to **develop innovative training for university staff** who may respond to disclosures of sexual violence, and to embed this within institutions.

The project began in March 2016 and will end with a **Findings Conference** in **London on November 2017**.
